One of the oldest members of Champagne's prestigious *Syndicat de Grandes Marques*, Champagne Deutz,,in the picturesque village of Aÿ on the southern slopes of the Montagne de Reims, has been making distinctive champagnes marked by finesse, elegance and complexity since 1838. Still based in the Deutz-Lallier family house, with its original *fin de siecle* décor, and surrounded by its prized Pinot Noir vineyards, Champagne Deutz – one of the best kept secrets in France – continues to win awards and new friends around the world.

Quinta do Noval, with its stunning, steeply-sloped vineyards perched high above the River Douro in Northern Portugal, is widely regarded as one of the leading lights in the world of Port. The 145 hectare estate still contains the iconic white-walled terraces from the last century, as well as the fabled pre-phylloxera Nacional parcel of vines. Situated just outside Pinhao in the heart of the Douro valley, Quinta do Noval is a single estate port shipper, focussing on quality, terroir-driven Ports and table wines.
